**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF  
FREMONT IN SUPPORT OF THE CONTINUED OPERATION OF THE  
NILES POST OFFICE, LOCATED AT 160 J STREET IN THE HISTORIC  
NILES DISTRICT OF FREMONT**

WHEREAS, the only post office in the historic Niles district of Fremont is located at 160 J Street; and

WHEREAS, the United States Postal Service established the Niles Post Office in 1873, before Fremont was incorporated as a city; and

WHEREAS, the Niles Post Office was built to serve the residents, visitors, and businesses of Fremont and is an important landmark in the community; and

WHEREAS, the Niles Post Office supports the vitality of the Niles business community; and

WHEREAS, access to a retail post office is vital to the on-going success of the Niles historic downtown; and

WHEREAS, the Niles Post Office is centrally located in the Niles neighborhood and accessible to residents throughout the neighborhood.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FREMONT HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

1. The City of Fremont hereby publicly supports the continued operation of the United States Post Office located at 160 J Street in the Niles neighborhood of Fremont.
2. It is essential for the continued economic well-being of the City of Fremont to maintain a post office that is readily accessible to the residents and businesses of Niles.
3. The City Clerk is directed to record this resolution in the appropriate record book and forward a duly certified copy to the United States Postal Service.


